The 34th Annual Meeting of the American Society of Preventive Oncology will be held in Bethesda, Maryland, March 21-23, 2010. The New Investigators Workshop, first held in 1993, has proven so successful that it will be held again in 2010. The workshop is an opportunity for pre- and postdoctoral trainees to meet with nationally recognized leaders in the field of preventive oncology, and to present their research for discussion and constructive criticism. The research may be completed work, work in progress, or ideas in the planning stages.

There is no application form. To apply, please submit the following:

- 1. A face sheet listing:**
 - a. Your (applicant's) name**
 - b. Your department, institution, mailing address, and email address**
 - c. The name, title, and email address of your sponsor (the principal investigator or mentor with whom you are working, who need not be an ASPO member)**
 - d. The title of your research project**
- 2. A 1-2 page description of your research project**
- 3. Your curriculum vitae**

The application deadline is 5:00 pm EST, Tuesday, December 1, 2009.
